The Power of The Arts



According to a ten-year national study of over 25,000 high school students, with lower socio-economic status, who participated in the arts, it was found that they had greater self-confidence, motivation, and empathy than did their non-arts peers. Evidence suggests that arts exposure can be instrumental in resolving conflicts, deterring problems with attendance and disruptive behavior, and building self-respect, self-efficacy, resilience, empathy, collaborative skills, and other characteristics and capacities that are linked to high student achievement.
